- Occupy thyself with these things; be wholly in them, that thy progress may be manifest to all. (I Timothy 4:15 Darby).

- Be diligent in these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy progress may be manifest unto all. (I Timothy 4:15 ASV).

- Occupation & Meditation Meditate upon these things (Occupy thyself with these things; Think on these things; Be diligent in these things).
- **Devotion** Give thyself wholly to them; (Be wholly in them; Devote your life to them).
- **Progress & Development** That thy profiting may appear to all. (That thy progress may be manifest unto all; So that everyone can see your progress; That thy progress may be manifest unto all).
